## **Job Specification**

### About the Role:

The Angel Shed Music Collective is a newly formed group for 12-19 year-olds where members learn from, share and make music with others. We aim to establish a positive environment where young people, regardless of their backgrounds or experiences, can work together inclusively to create music over which they have shared creative control and ownership.

With devising and sharing ideas at the core of all sessions, we encourage members to support one another in workshops and rehearsals through to performances. The Music Collective is delivered inclusively to ensure members are given the most relevant type of support. We provide 1:1 assistance for members where necessary.

This role will help facilitate and support growth in the Music Collective, stimulating and furthering music skills through engaging and appropriate activities. The successful applicant will enable creative responses from participants to flourish, thereby enhancing their musical, personal and social development.

The role will include the following:

- Assisting the Artistic Lead for Music in the running of sessions in Islington on Monday evenings during term time (7.00 - 9.00pm).
- Assisting the Artistic Lead for Music in the planning of sessions and activities for the term.
- Leading small groups in specialist areas during sessions (composition, songwriting, singing, or instrumental performance).
- Supporting (1:1 where necessary) and performing with the Collective at end-of-term performance.
- Assisting in setting up and packing down rehearsal equipment.
- Being responsible for basic admin at rehearsals (e.g. attendance registers).
- Assisting in training volunteer practitioners.

## **Person Specification**

We are looking for a creative and inspiring music leader.

You must:

- have strong musical skills.
- be an aspiring music leader with a positive personality.
- be self-assured in your ability to support the musical aspirations of others and create an inclusive and accessible space for collaboration.
- have the confidence and presence to engage well with a large group of young musicians.
- be able to foster good and supportive working relationships with staff, volunteer practitioners, and members.
- be someone who will value and maintain the positive and inclusive ethos of Angel Shed.
- be able to offer expertise that will continue to challenge and develop the collective.

You will ideally:

- have experience of leading workshops for young people.
- have experience working in SEN/D settings.
- be an accomplished and confident singer.

Useful music skills for this role could include: improvisation, multi-instrumentalist (particularly guitar, bass, drums, or keyboard), songwriting/lyricist, rap/spoken word, recording/live sound.
